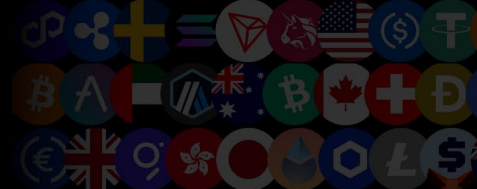

OMNIA EXCHANGE COOKIE POLICY

1. INTRODUCTION

This Policy sets out how cookies are used on omniaexchange.com (the "Website"). Omnia Exchange is operated by LMAX Group ("we", "us", "our"). This Policy explains what cookies we use on the Website, why we use them, and how you can manage your choices.

We respect your right to privacy and are committed to protecting it. Please read the following carefully to ensure you understand our practices regarding the use of cookies on the Website. This Cookie Policy should be read alongside the LMAX Group Privacy Policy, which explains how we handle your personal data more generally.

Strictly necessary cookies are essential and are always active. All other cookies, including analytics and advertising cookies such as the LinkedIn Insight Tag, are only set where you have given your consent. You give or refuse this consent through the cookie banner shown when you first visit the Website. Analytics and advertising cookies are blocked by default until you accept them, and you can change or withdraw your choice at any time (see section 6).

2. WHAT ARE 'COOKIES'?

Cookies are small data files that are downloaded to a user's computer, phone or tablet when you visit a website. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies. They help website operators to, for example, recognise a user that has visited a website previously and to analyse behaviour in order to improve the user experience. Further details on the cookies used on our website and their purposes are set out below.

3. WHAT COOKIES WILL BE USED AND FOR WHAT PURPOSE?

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential in order to enable you to browse our website and use its features. The information collected by these cookies relates to the operation of our website, for example to keep your session stable and secure while browsing, and to store your cookie consent choices so we can respect them on future visits. These cookies do not require consent.

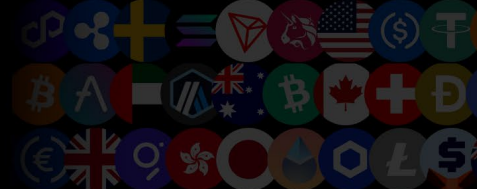
Performance cookies

In order to improve user experience on our website, evaluate the performance of our content and fix technical issues or errors on pages or web forms, we use performance and analytics tools, including from third parties such as Google Analytics. These cookies collect information such as the number of user visits or returning visitors to a website. They are used to generate aggregate data and are only set where you have accepted analytics cookies.

Targeting or marketing cookies

As part of our marketing initiatives these cookies collect information about your browsing habits (for example, which source a particular visit is coming from) and inferred interests in order to make advertising more relevant to you. They are also used to limit the number of times you see an advert, and to measure the effectiveness and performance of an advertising campaign. Some of these cookies are placed by our third-party advertising networks.

On omniaexchange.com this category includes the LinkedIn Insight Tag, which we use for conversion tracking, website retargeting and building marketing audiences. These cookies are set by LinkedIn (part of Microsoft) and are only placed where you have accepted marketing cookies.



Functionality cookies

These cookies enable our website to remember choices you make and your personal preferences in order to improve the user experience, for example by avoiding you having to re-enter details on each visit to our website.

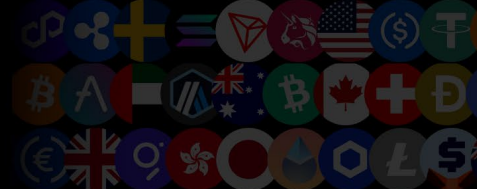
The main cookies used on omniaexchange.com are set out in the table below. Cookie names and durations may change over time, and cookies in the analytics and marketing categories are only set once you have accepted the relevant category.

4. HOW LONG WILL THE COOKIES REMAIN?

The single session cookie is a temporary cookie which remains in the cookie file of your browser until you close the browser.

The other cookies will remain in the cookie file of your browser after the closing of the browser and will become active again when you reopen the Website. These cookies have different expiration dates, as set out in the table above. Following expiry of a cookie, a new version of that cookie will be downloaded when you next visit the Website, unless you have withdrawn your consent in the meantime.



5. THIRD PARTY COOKIES

Some cookies are provided on our behalf by trusted third-party service providers to aid with user experience, reporting of user behaviour, market research, providing advertisements according to a user's interests and improving the Website functionality. This user behaviour is analysed in order to provide an improved user experience.

The main third parties used on omniaexchange.com are Google (analytics) and LinkedIn (advertising and audience measurement). These providers may process data outside the UK, including in the United States. Where they do, LMAX will put in place appropriate safeguards or undertake checks on the adequacy of the applicable regulatory regime.

6. HOW DO I TURN COOKIES OFF?

You can accept or reject analytics and marketing cookies, and change or withdraw your consent at any time, using the cookie banner and the cookie preferences control on the Website. Withdrawing consent stops further cookies in that category being set.

You do not have to accept cookies, but if you opt to turn off or delete cookies generated via our website, it may not perform as it has been designed to, possibly reducing the functionality on our website, the options available to you, as well as the performance of our website during your visit.

All modern browsers allow you to change your cookie settings. These settings will typically be found in the 'options' or 'preferences' menu of your browser.
